2022 TJRA Important Information

--ALL RODEOS WILL START AT 9:00 AM--

ENTRIES:

- MEMBERS: 2021 TJRA members will be allowed to call in and enter WITH paying a \$25.00 late fee, as well as ALL rodeos. Entry fees MUST be paid when pre-entering TO AVOID A LATE FEE. Entry fee checks will not be cashed until the Monday after the rodeo. The first rodeo postmark is January 24th. All entries should be postmarked two Mondays prior to the rodeo you are entering. There is no guarantee your entry will be received by the Monday before the rodeo even when mailing two weeks prior to the rodeo. (Leaving your entry at each rodeo is the only guarantee your entry will not be late.) A call in will be available the Monday before each rodeo for TJRA members. Remember, if you call in a \$25.00 late fee will be charged.
- o **NON-MEMBERS:** may call in the Monday prior to the rodeo or enter at the rodeo 1 hour prior to the rodeo start time. There will be a \$10.00 non-member fee for each rodeo.
- Call in for the first rodeos will be Monday, January 31st will be from 6:00 9:00. For all other rodeos call in will be 7:00 9:00.
- ATTENTION: TJRA now has a QR code for paying entries, t-shirts, hoodies, caps, etc.
 This will allow you to pay through the TJRA Paypal account. You may also still write checks.
- Each member will be required to sell \$100.00 worth of raffle tickets for a four-wheeler or WW stock trailer.
- All Finals contestants MUST bring an auction item of \$25.00 value for the silent auction to be held at the TJRA Finals.
- In order to qualify for the TJRA Finals, a competitor must compete in at least 10 of the 18 rodeos and be in the top 15. ALL FEES AND FINES MUST BE TAKEN CARE OF TO ABLE TO ENTER THE FINALS.
- Any TJRA member that sells \$500 or more of the required raffle will be given a 2023 TJRA membership. Also, for each \$100 sold over the required \$100 the member's name will be put in a drawing for a 2023 membership.
- All contestants, while in the arena must be in official dress code.
- Returned check policy: All returned checks must be paid in cash at the following rodeo as well as
 the entry fee for that rodeo before your child or children will be allowed to compete. In the event of
 a second returned check the remaining rodeos will be required to pay in cash or money order for the
 remaining of the rodeo season.
- Draw outs: Draw outs must be done by contacting rodeo secretary by 6:oopm on the Wednesday before the rodeo. Any time after Wednesday you MUST have a written doctor or vet release or it will be consider a turn out and entry fees will not be rolled over or refunded.
- In the event of a question or concern during an event, PARENTS MUST GO TO AN EVENT DIRECTOR IN THE ARENA IMMEDIATELY, not the judge.

2022 TJRA Important Information

- Church services will be at 8:30am on Sunday before the rodeo for those who wish to attend.
- All events will run at their regular time at each rodeo.
- All rough stock riders (including Mutton Bustin) are required to wear a helmet, protective vest and mouthpiece, excluding pony bareback. Please refer to the rule book referring to the pony bareback riding equipment.
- **FORMS**: included in your membership packet is only one entry form and one membership form. If you have more than one child, please make as many copies you will need. Also, I need **one entry form for EACH RODEO**. Many times only one form is filled out and fees are not paid correctly.
- Be sure to put a contact mobile number and an email on your membership form. These will be used for reminders.
- ALL MEMBERS please take responsibilities in gathering as many sponsors and selling program
 ads as you can to help promote the TJRA and add to the year-end awards. Start now as most
 businesses began to budget at the beginning of the year. There is a sponsorship packet in your
 membership packet and there is one on the TJRA website. We need as many as we can get as
 early as we can get to ensure the year-end awards as possible.
